- Free counseling services for adults and children who are victims of crime.
- Free Legal Advocacy for victims of crime navigating family court.
- Runaway/ Homeless Youth Street Outreach services.
- Positive Youth Connections provides prevention education to middle and high school students.
- The MARS Project (Men Against Rape and Sexism) provides prevention education at NAU.
