




Since 1972, CCC&Y has existed to provide leadership in developing community-wide strategies that enhance the well-being of children and youth in Coconino County

Committees	Functions

Coalition Fosters Connections	Preventing the negative effects of foster care and promotion of collective impact, trauma response, and strong communities at the community level
